Old Business:

Easter Event with egg hunt and craft, and 1 Easter story book/family, will be March 30th will discuss start time next meeting. We will ask for donations of candy and small coins for eggs.

The Team discussed how locking the doors during church services is going. One Sunday it was so cold that the Ring Doorbell cameras didn't work so two safety members monitored the locked doors.

Garrett taught a CPR class for four people. He will be teaching another class soon.

Policy Booklet – Waiting for Youth Committee to meet to finalize a few youth policies. The Youth Committee is doing some final edits and should have their policies ready by their next meeting.

Combining Lots – Margie Lee talked to Heidi Hamelton at City Hall. Heidi recommended that lots 201 and 223 be combined because the church structure and parking lot is on both of those lots. Heidi said there are no costs are involved in combining these lots. Council approved combining these lots at no cost to the church. The remaining lots we own will remain separate.

Tithe – We voted to give our tithe of \$2,344.40 to ARC

Update Check Signers and Debit Card – Sierra Halverson has been hired as the new Church Coordinator after Darcee Wenning moved. Council approved having Sierra be a check signer and getting her a church debit card.

Margie Lee reported that a church Amazon account was set up to order supplies needed for church.

Pastor Kent Sperry – The church council recommends a 3-month paid Sabbatical for Pastor Kent which will need to be approved by a congregational vote.
